10.1 These notes were taken after the A.G.M had been officially closed by the Chairman and several members had left the meeting for home.

It came to the attention of the outgoing Secretary (while going through the Affiliation forms to check whether the Examination Secretary's receipt had been sent) that Graham Whittaker had not affiliated before the 31stDecember 2001, to enable him to vote or be eligible to register a proposal or seconding at the Annual General Meeting.

This was pointed out to the Chairman, who proceeded to ask someone to bring Graham Whittaker back into the meeting, after informing Graham the reasons why he had to return. The Chairman then asked Graham to please advise him of what votes he had cast during the Annual General Meeting, the outgoing Secretary pointed out that this was unconstitutional and that the whole Meeting should be null and void! As members had already left and gone home.

It was also pointed out that Graham was also the seconder to the proposed new Secretary, thus making his election null and void, the Chairman's reply was that the proposed new Secretary had still been elected by the margin of 8 to 7. The outgoing Secretary protested that the proposed new Secretary still needed a Seconder, the Chairman was not prepared to listen to reason and declared that the proposed new Secretary did not require a seconder as you (outgoing Secretary) have lost on votes anyway.
